National Championships - Ladies and Mens

Competitions are open to Full Members of Spencer Melksham.

Entries are submitted through the Club. Payment is made on joining night and Club Treasurer pays Bowls Wiltshire.

The Clubs National / County Coordinator registers this information with Bowls Wiltshire who administer these Championship events prior to the National Finals.

Fixtures are available on the Bowls Wiltshire Web site.

Championships events begin at County stages with successful players progressing to the Bowls England National Finals. All events are organised on a knock-out basis, with the early rounds played locally and administered by Bowls Wiltshire. The National Finals take place at Victoria Park, Royal Leamington Spa.

Players must play all Championships out of one club only.

All events are played in accordance with BE Rules and Regulations and the current Laws of the Sport of Bowls v4. Bowls England rules are reg 50-70 (Championships and Competitions) and regulations 1-49 for Clubs.

BOWLS ENGLAND

Individual National Competitions

Competitions are open to Full Members of Spencer Melksham.

Entries are submitted by individuals through Bowls England Web Site where fixtures will be published.

The early qualifying rounds are held locally on a home or away basis or neutral green. All area winners will qualify for the National Finals.

All events are organised on a knock-out basis, with the early rounds played locally and the National Finals at Victoria Park, Royal Leamington Spa.

Matches during the qualifying rounds are arranged by the players.

All National Competitions shall comprise of geographic areas to reduce travelling in the early rounds wherever possible. Counties with a high number of entries may be split into two areas, counties with a low number of entries may be paired with a neighbouring county to form an area.

All events are played in accordance with our Rules and Regulations and the current Laws of the Sport of Bowls v4. Bowls England rules are reg 50-70 (Championships and Competitions) and regulations 1-49 for Clubs.

Club Captain or Club Vice Captain will select teams.

All events are organised on a knock-out basis, with the early rounds played locally and the National Finals at Victoria Park, Royal Leamington Spa.

The early qualifying rounds are held locally on a home or away basis before going inter area/region.

Matches during the qualifying rounds are arranged by the captains.

The qualifying rounds are held either on weekday evenings or at weekends – this is agreed by the players.

BOWLS ENGLAND

Inter-County National Competitions

Inter-County Competitions give players the opportunity to represent their county in competitive events.

Bowls Wiltshire enter these competitions and select players to represent the county. Each county selection committee has its own criteria based on ability, achievements, and current form.

Where applicable the Clubs National / County Coordinator will send out trial dates to all members. Availability sheets for John's Trial will be sent out to each Club, with a return date, for any member to put their name down. John's Trophy & Walker Cup teams will be selected from this list.

When representing the County, county uniform must be worn.

All events are organised by the participating counties, with the early rounds played regionally. The National Finals take place at Victoria Park, Royal Leamington Spa.

The draw for all these competitions are made by Bowls England, with the venues arranged by the County Associations.
